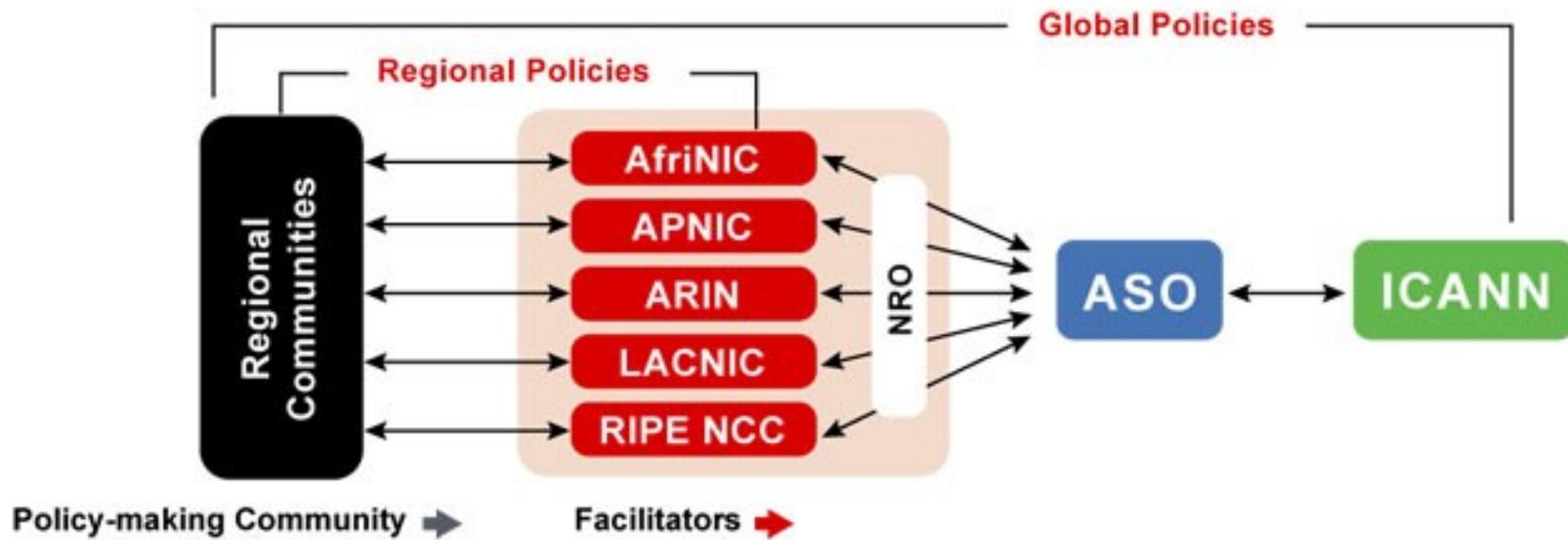
Introduction

- This policy defines distribution of last pieces of IANA IPv4 address to RIRs.

- Two proposals discussed at RIPE 55
 - Prop 2007-03 : distribute 1 */8 to each RIR
 - Prop 2007-06 : distribute 2 */8 to each RIR

- We now have a joined proposal with N=1.

Status in other RIR:

- ❑ ARIN: Last Call since Apr. 14.
- ❑ LACNIC: To be introduced in LACNIC XI. Previous version already got consensus.
- ❑ AFRINIC: To be introduced in AFRINIC 8. Previous version already got consensus.
- ❑ APNIC: Under discussion, will be discussed in APNIC26.

Reserved IANA pool



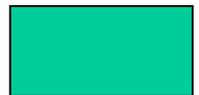
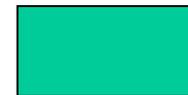
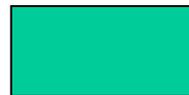
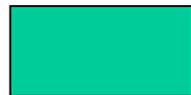
