- Make PA more attractive than PI
- Prevention of abuse, hijacking, etc
- Tighten up on sub-assignment
- “Responsible Stewardship”
- Get good policy into place before any IPv6 PI is assigned



Policy vs Operations

- Policy states “Deal with The Problem”
- Pre-implementation planning requires
 - budgetary planning
 - liaison with NL tax authorities
 - update to RIPE NCC Articles of Association
 - legal opinion on what’s important for LIR end-user contracts
 - approval at RIPE General Meeting
- Implementation
 - carefully managed multi-year project
 - ERX will probably be put at the bottom of the list



Mechanisms to Assign PI Resources

- via existing LIR
 - it would be helpful for the RIPE NCC to provide a sample outline contract to help LIRs
- direct from the RIPE NCC
 - there are special cases (e.g. ccTLDs, smaller IXPs) where political neutrality is as much of a problem as paying multiple kilo-euros
 - probably will be implemented through associate membership category
 - Lower cost, fewer rights and responsibilities
