Terms and Conditions

- These were approved subject to some corrections.
- Final document will be published shortly after RIPE 56 when corrections applied.



Main Issues

- All users have to adhere to these Terms and Conditions
- Hierarchy in use (see definitions): Registrant, maintainer and user
- Only maintainers may update the RIPE DB
- Maintainers responsible for the accuracy of the data
- Purpose of the RIPE DB is defined (limits the use)
- Link with Acceptable Use Policy (still has to be finalised)
- RIPE NCC can remove data (Removal of personal data procedure)



Implementation

- Publish document after RIPE 56
- One month period for comments
- Review of comments and make effective.



Removal of Personal Data

- This procedure was approved.
- Final document will be published shortly after RIPE 56.



Main Points

- Any request will always be referred to the maintainer first.
- RIPE NCC will only take action if maintainer does not respond or does not satisfy users request.
- Some personal data will not be removed.



Bulk Access

- NRTM procedure without personal data was approved.
- This is now in use, see <http://www.ripe.net/db/support/about-nrtm.html>
- No bulk access will be allowed to personal data for any purpose.
